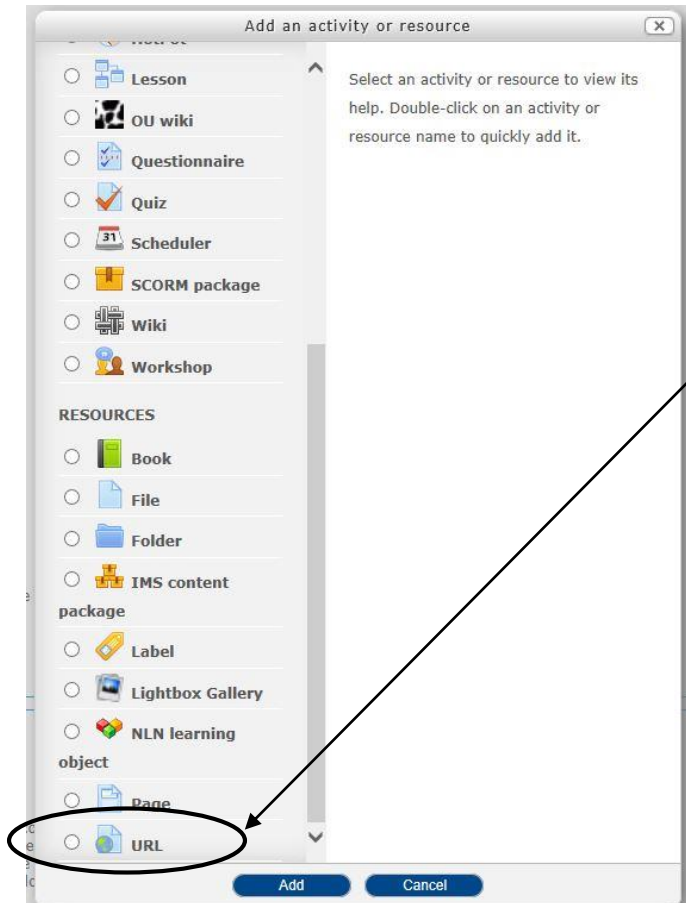
To add a web link, you'll need to logon to Moodle, access your course page and turn editing on

Turn editing on

1. Go to the Topic area you'd like the web page (URL) to be displayed in > click the '**Add an activity or resource**' option.



2. The '**add an activity or resource**' menu will appear > scroll down through the menu options to the heading '**resources**' > and select the '**URL**' option > then click '**Add**'

3. Enter the **name** of your web page – this should give your students a good idea of what the web page is > and a brief **description**.

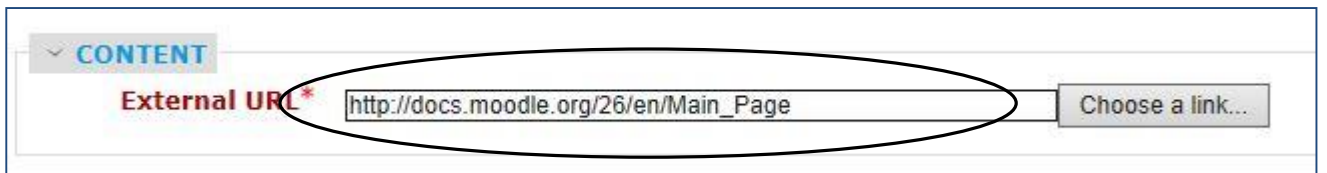
