

How to embed a Youtube video into your iLearn course area



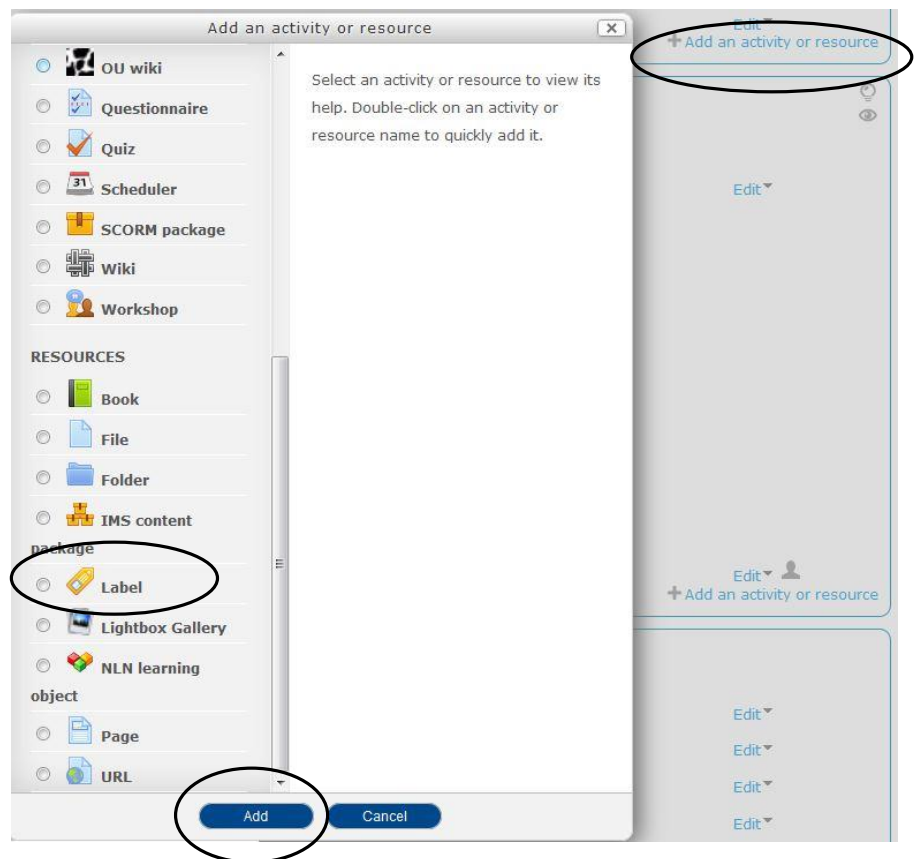

1. Go to your course area and click turn editing on

Turn editing on

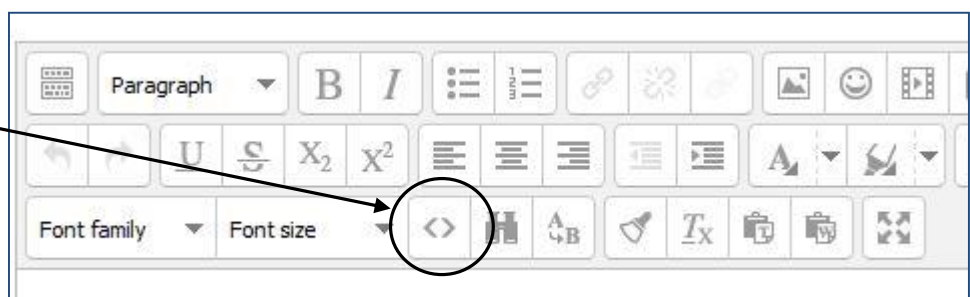
2. Choose which section you'd like to add your video to and click the '+ add an activity or resource' option.

The activity and resource menu will appear – scroll through the list and select the option 'label' and then click the 'add' button ...



3. Ensure you can see you the full toolbar by clicking the 'toolbar toggle' button

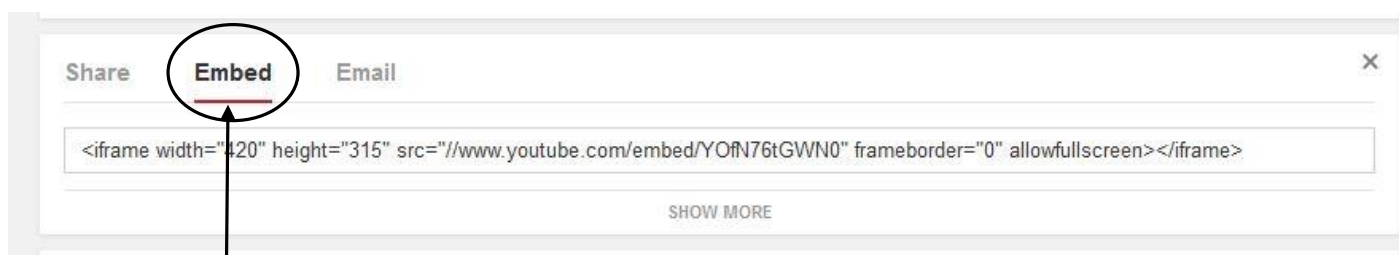
4. Click the 'edit html source' button



5. Now you have your html source code window open, you need to search for the Youtube video you wish to embed and locate the code...
Open a new browser tab > go to youtube – www.youtube.com

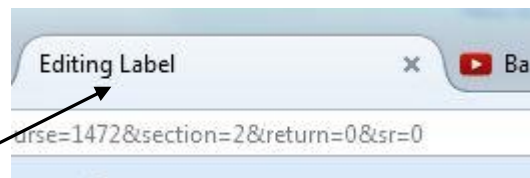


6. Type in key word(s) to search for your video



8. Click on the embed option, ensure all the text is highlighted and copy it (Ctrl + c)

9. Go back to Moodle by clicking on the correct tab in your browser...



10. Paste (Ctrl + v) the code you copied into the html source code editor > and click the 'update' button.



11. Click the **'save and return to course'** button

12. Your video should display embedded in your course page, like this...
